



“Total Obedience Causes Total Prosperity”

Texts: Deuteronomy 29:9, Deut. 11:8-28, Deut. 28:1-14, Job 36:9-11, Jer. 7:23-28

From the Old Covenant days when God set Moses as the primary set Pastoral leader of His Chosen people obedience has always been the link to Supernatural God ordained prosperity for His people. The primary function of the spiritual Pastoral leader is to teach God's commands and word so His people can know specifically what to give Total Obedience to in order to have Total God ordained Prosperity.

The book of Deuteronomy gives much attention to Pastor Moses' sermons on this subject to help us learn about what was written before our time so we can implement it now in our time and experience God's prosperity.

Romans 15:4 For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope.

We must also realize that it is God's will that we prosper and have abundance in life.

III John 2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health even as thy soul prospereth.

Amplified John 10:10 The thief comes

only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows).

It's time for us as God's last days End Time Kingdom heirs to walk in **Total Obedience and have Total Prosperity** so we can be a blessing to God's vision and purpose for the church in these last days before Jesus returns.

It's God's will that we prosper in all we do if we keep the covenant, obey His word and live righteously.

Deut 29:9 Keep therefore the words of this covenant and do them, that ye may prosper in all that ye do.

Psalms 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

2: But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in His law doth he meditate day and night.

3: And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Wow! This means unlimited prosperity.

Deuteronomy 11:8-28 deals with the promise of prosperous land and living conditions, long life, and multiplied days, possessing whatever land we tread on, victory over our enemies, days like heaven on earth, and total blessings if we operate in Total Obedience to God and His word.

Deuteronomy 28:1-14 is loaded with the blessings and prosperity in Supernatural proportions in all areas of life for operating in Total Obedience to God and His taught word.

We have a new Covenant that's established upon better promises.

Hebrews 8:6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry by how much also He is the mediator of a better covenant which was established upon better promises.

7: For if that first covenant had been faultless then should no place have been sought for the second.

8: For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days, come saith the Lord when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:

9: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they

continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord. 10: For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord. I will put my law into their mind, and write them in their hearts and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people.

Many times Total Obedience can only take place when we receive correction. When we refuse or reject correction we hinder our ability to totally obey God so we can be eligible for Total Prosperity.

God classified Solomon as the wisest richest man before or after his time. Let's see what he teaches about how correction when received and accepted can lead to total obedience as well as wisdom which cause supernatural prosperity and success.

Proverbs 3:11 My son despise not the chastening of the Lord; neither be weary of his correction: 12: For whom the Lord loveth He correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.

Notice very carefully how wisdom comes as a result of receiving and accepting Godly correction. Notice also how unlimited and supernatural the wealth and prosperity is that

comes as a result of God’s wisdom.

13: Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding.

14: For the merchandise of it is better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold.

15: She is more precious than rubies: and all the things thou canst desire are not to be compared unto her.

Notice the promise of long life from wisdom.

16: Length of days is in her right hand; and in her left hand riches and honour.

Solomon also puts emphasis on receiving instructions from seasoned matured wise people in order to get wisdom to live in total obedience to God to have total prosperity. Proverbs Chapter 4 is an excellent example of this principle the way Solomon wrote this it’s clear that the instruction and wisdom is coming from someone from a mature spiritual father category of person.

Proverbs 4:1 Hear ye children the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding.

2: For I give you good doctrine, forsake ye not my law.

Please note that the word doctrine comes from the original Hebrew word *leh-kakh* and means learning coming from teaching and instructing from a teacher.

3: For I was my father’s son, tender and only beloved in the sight of my mother.

4: He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words: keep my commandments, and live.

5: Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not, neither decline from the words of my mouth.

7: Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.

10: Hear, O my son, and receive my sayings; and the years of thy life shall be many

11: I have taught thee in the way of wisdom; I have led thee in the right paths.

13: Take fast hold of instruction; let her not go: keep her, for she is thy life.

Notice how much emphasis is placed on loving to Obey His Commands in certain verses in Deuteronomy Chapter 11. Also notice the emphasis on receiving and keeping the word of God commanded and taught by the Pastor or spiritual leader.

Deuteronomy 11:8 Therefore shall ye keep all the commandments which I

command you this day, that ye may be strong and go in and possess the land, whither ye go to possess it:

9: And that ye may prolong your days in the land which the Lord sware unto your fathers to give unto them and to their seed, a land that floweth with milk and honey.

13: And it shall come to pass, if ye shall hearken diligently unto my commandments which I command you this day, to love the Lord your God and to serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul.

Please note that Pastor Moses is the “I” being mentioned so He’s doing the commanding and teaching they must obey.

21: That your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children, in the land which the Lord sware unto your fathers to give them, as the days of heaven upon the earth.

Wow! **Total Obedience Causes Total Prosperity** of life and days like heaven on earth for us and our children.

22: For if ye shall diligently keep all these commandments which I command you, to do them, to love the Lord your God, to

walk in all His ways, and to cleave unto him.

23: Then will the Lord drive out all these nations from before you, and ye shall possess greater nations and mightier than yourselves,

24: Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even unto the uttermost sea shall your coast be.

25: There shall no man be able to stand before you: for the Lord your God shall lay the fear of you and the dread of you upon all the land that ye shall tread upon, as he hath said unto you.
