



“Where You Are Is Not Your Final Destination”

Texts: Isaiah 14:24-27, Isaiah 49:5-7, Isaiah 42:6-8, Job 8:5-7, Job 23:10-14, 1Corinthians 2:9-16

No matter where you are in life right now it's just a temporary place in physical or natural time and existence, but eternally and spiritually you are already designated for God's, Divine destination of miraculous success, prosperity, supernatural life, victory, and great increase that your eyes haven't seen, ears haven't heard, and your heart hasn't perceived.

God has already eternally prepared your destination for you and desires that you experience it eventually. Regardless of where you are in life now God's Prophetic word declares and promises that He will be your strength, and you shall be His light to the nations of the earth and His end time salvation voice. He also promises that out of all the kings and princes in the earth, he shall choose you to demonstrate His End Time Glory through. See also Isaiah 60:1-15. You must realize that wherever you are now is just a temporary natural time zone, and can't prevent God's final eternal divine destination ordained for you from being reached. Your best days are yet to come with God's greatest divine purpose He has ordained for your life.

Isaiah 49:5 And now, saith the Lord that formed me from the womb to be His servant, to bring Jacob again to Him,

though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be glorious in the eyes of the Lord, and my God shall be my strength.

God is promising to be all the strength we need to endure our temporary time zones and the temporary situation they contain. He's promising to get the glory of our lives.

6: And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth.

We will speak God's prophetic word of salvation up until the end of the earth realm dispensation that precedes the return of Jesus.

7: Thus saith the Lord, the Redeemer of Israel, and His Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the Lord that is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel and He shall choose thee.

God even promises to not give His glory to anyone besides us in the closing days of the earth prior to the return of Jesus. See also Isaiah 60:1-15.

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Isaiah 42:6 I the Lord have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people for a light of the Gentiles.

8: I am the Lord that is my name and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.

Don't let where you currently or are not in life discourage you because it's just a temporary time zone you are traveling through to get to God's Divine Eternal purpose, and your Divine God ordained destination. Keep trusting in and declaring His prophetic word in your life, and expect your latter end to greatly increase no matter how small your beginning has been in life as declared in Job 8:5-7.

Isaiah 14:24 The Lord of host hath sworn, saying, Surely as I have thought, so shall it come to pass; and as I have purposes, so shall it stand.

Please note that the word purposes comes from the Hebrew word yaw-ats, and means; to advise, to deliberate, or resolve, to consult, to give, or take counsel.

God has advised, deliberated about, and counseled himself about His divine, eternal purpose, plan, and destiny for your life, and no

one and nothing can prevent it from coming to pass, not even your temporary time zone you're passing through.

26: This is the purpose that is purposed upon the whole earth: and this is the hand that is stretched out upon all the nations.

27: For the Lord of host hath purposed, and who shall disannul it? And His hand is stretched out, and who shall turn it back?

No one or nothing can turn God's hand back that's already stretched out over your life and the divine, glorious eventual destination He's ordained for you. No matter how small, lacking, deficient, and even insignificant your life seems to be God promises to increase and prosper your latter end. In fact, notice carefully what Job says in Job 8:5-7 about your great increase at your latter end.

Job 8:5 If thou wouldst seek unto God bedtimes, and make thy supplication to the Almighty.

Please note that bedtimes means, quickly, or early at a task. We must seek Him as stated in Hebrews 11:6.

6: If thou wert pure and upright, surely now He would awake for thee, and make

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the habitation of thy righteousness prosperous.

It's worth not I know that God's promising to prosper you for the righteousness you dwell or live in.

7: Though thy beginning was small, yet thy latter end should greatly increase.

Even though you might be going through a trying or testing time you shall come forth as gold eventually. In fact, it's in the midst of the trial or furnace of affliction where God chooses His best vessels as clearly seen in Isaiah 48:9-11.

Isaiah 48:9 For my name's sake will I defer mine anger, and for my praise will I refrain for thee, that I cut thee not off.

10: Behold, I have refined thee, but not with silver; I have chosen thee in the furnace of affliction.

11: For mine own sake, even for mine own sake, will I do it: for now should my name be polluted? And I will not give my glory unto another.

No matter what your current temporary time zone is like right now God intends to get the glory out of your life, so hold on, persevere, persist, and pursue God's divine eternal destination for your life.

Job 23:10 But He knoweth the way that I take: when He hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold.

11: My foot hath held His steps, His way have I kept, and not declined.

12: Neither have I gone back from the commandment of His lips; I have esteemed the words of His mouth more than my necessary food.

You must be more hungry and desperate about God's word than even daily natural food. Remember what Jesus said in Matthew 4:4 and Luke 4:4.

Even if you're in a current dark, dismal, sad, weeping time God promises it will come to an end, and your morning joy time will come.

Psalm 30:1 I will extol thee, O Lord, for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.

2: O Lord my God I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.

3: O Lord, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.

4: Sing unto the Lord, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of His holiness.

5: For His anger endureth but a moment; in his favor is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the

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morning.

6: And in my prosperity I said, I shall never be moved.

God's purpose, plan, and your final destination includes peace, joy, prosperity, and great and mighty things He's prepared for you that you haven't seen heard, or perceived in your heart yet.

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

The word end comes from the Hebrew word akh-areeth and means: last, future, posterity, latter end time, reward.

12: Then shall you call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you.

13: And ye shall seek me and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.

14: And I will be found of you, saith the Lord: and I will turn away your captivity, and I will gather you from all the nations, and from all the places whither I have driven you, saith the Lord, and I will bring you again into the place whence I caused you to be carried away captive.

I Corinthians 2:9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him.

How do you prove you love God? By doing what John 14:21-23 says.

10: But God hath rewarded them unto us by His Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

11: For what man knoweth the things of man, save the Spirit of man, but the Spirit of God.

12: Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God, that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

13: Which things also we speak, not in words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

This is where many Christians miss it because of not being filled with the Holy Spirit who is the great teacher and revealer of God's truth according to John 14:26 and John 16:13.

The Apostles did their greatest miraculous works after being filled with the Holy Ghost as shown in Acts 2:1-4,7, Acts 3:1-16, Acts 4:7-12, and Acts 5:1-16.

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14: But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

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
